They are surgically invasive devices intended for transient-term use (less than 60 minutes); to aid the surgeon's handling of delicate sutures; they are not intended for implantation.

PRECAUTIONS: No precautions for disposal apply. This device is single use only; reuse may lead to patient cross contamination and/or device failure. Do not re-sterilize. Re-sterilization of the device may result in loss

of product functionality. **CAUTION:** Prior to use visually inspect packaging. Do not use if damaged, opened or breached as sterility cannot be guaranteed.

CONTRAINDICATIONS: Not intended for use in direct contact with the central nervous system.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. After removing pad from pouch, remove backing to expose adhesive and apply to appropriate surface.
- 2. Insert jaws of instrument into suture booties and remove from pad.
- 3. Upon completion of procedure, dispose of both used and unused booties according to hospital protocol.
